COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS



» The State of Nebraska's laws provide cyclists with all the rights and responsibilities of legal users of the road. This information is part of the licensing training and exam for motor vehicle drivers. When the first bike lanes were installed in Lincoln, both City staff and Transit operators were trained on how to properly use vehicles in relationship to the bike lanes on the Downtown streets they were located. Bicycle

education and activities are conducted annually in a low to moderate income neighborhood promoting bicycling. The Parks and Recreation department provides bicycle education as part of their after school and summer playground programs. The Department offers two week long nature camps focused around riding bicycles on Lincoln's trails network. Education is part of that program.
