COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS



» Cambridge is thrilled to highlight the establishment of Hubway, our regional bike share program. Hubway has been enormously successful, accumulating 675,000 trips in the 16 months since its launch, 50% higher than the most optimistic projection. As a regional system, Hubway is a partnership of the member communities as well as MAPC, (Metropolitan Area Planning Council, the regional planning agency), with support from MassDOT (CMAQ grant) and the MBTA, our regional

transit agency (FTA grant)

- » Results from our robust bicycle count program demonstrate that bicycling has tripled over the past decade.
- » Construction has commenced on two more cycle track locations
- » Completion of the North Point Bicycle/Pedestrian Bridge
