# What is NCSL? National Conference of State Legislatures

- Non-profit, bi-partisan organization of state legislatures.

#### **Complete Streets**




What are complete streets?

A transportation policy that considers the needs of a variety of users—bicyclists, people with disabilities, automobile drivers and pedestrians—when planning and designing a transportation network.

The purpose is to create streets, sidewalks, bike paths, etc. that are more welcoming, easier to navigate, and safer for all transportation users.




## **State Complete Streets Policies**





#### **Typical Components of Complete Streets**

- Policy Jurisdiction
- Project Coverage
- Users
- Exceptions



### **Bicycle Funding**

- Dedicated Minimums (Examples: HI, MI, OR)
- Appropriations (Example: DE)
- Motor Fuel Taxes (Example: CA)
- Dedicated Funds (Examples: DC, IL)
- Bike-sharing (Examples: CO, FL, HI, MD, VA)
